This Model Statement of Authority is a template. A licensed Sovereign Cell completes and publishes it as the public declaration of the legal and institutional basis of its powers. It operates under the Constitution of the JIL Federation.

2.2 The Cell operates under a license from JIL Sovereign Holdings for use of the JIL Layer-1 Core. The license does not itself create governmental or monetary authority. It authorizes technical operation on the Core.

2.3 This Statement is published so that every participant, counterparty Cell, auditor, and regulator can identify the source and scope of the powers exercised by this Cell.

3. Scope of Authority

3.1 This Cell is authorized to:

- Define, issue, redeem, and manage currency objects under the law applicable to the operator;
- Establish and enforce participant eligibility, identity, and compliance requirements within its domain;
- Set and publish local transfer policy, including rejection rights;
- Enter Trust Corridors and Digital Treaties with other Sovereign Cells by consent;
- Maintain treasury, registry, and attestation functions for its own currency objects and participants;
- Establish internal governance institutions consistent with the Constitution of the JIL Federation;
- Amend its own Cell Charter and this Statement according to the process in Section 6, provided such amendment does not violate the Federation Constitution or the license.

3.2 This Cell is not authorized to:

- Control or amend the JIL Layer-1 Core protocol;
 - Exercise monetary or policy authority over any other Sovereign Cell;
 - Hold or custody value belonging to another Cell in the course of corridor facilitation;
 - Claim original authority for automated systems beyond the derived grants described in Section 5.
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4. Governance Institutions

4.1 Legislative or policy-establishing function:

5.3 No automated system possesses original authority under this Statement.

6. Amendment of this Statement

6.1 This Statement may be amended only by the process that governs amendment of the Cell Charter, and only by the institution identified in Section 4.1.

6.2 Every amendment shall be:

- Published with the effective date and the prior version number;
- Preserved in the Cell's institutional archive;
- Notified to JIL Sovereign Holdings as required by the license;
- Recorded so that counterparties can verify the current scope of authority.

6.3 An amendment that would place the Cell in violation of the Constitution of the JIL Federation or of its license is void to the extent of the conflict.

7. Relationship to Law and to the Federation

7.1 This Statement does not supersede the law of [jurisdiction]. The Cell remains fully subject to that law and to all applicable regulatory requirements.

7.2 This Statement operates under the Constitution of the JIL Federation. On matters of Federation order, the Federation Constitution prevails. On matters of the Cell's own legal authority, the law of [jurisdiction] prevails.

7.3 JIL Sovereign Holdings maintains the Core and licenses its use. Holdings does not set the monetary policy, participant rules, or currency design of this Cell.

8. Publication and Attestation

8.1 This Statement shall be published in human-readable form and in a form that permits cryptographic attestation of its integrity and version.

8.2 The current version of this Statement is the only authoritative expression of the Cell's declared authority. Prior versions remain in the archive for continuity and audit.
